



Pug Gabrel Academic Excellence Scholarship Application

Pug Gabrel was a man who late in life risked all he had to start a new venture. Today, his legacy allows him to help you and your child have a better opportunity for Christian education. Because it's a challenge to provide the best education for your child with only \$2,500 per year in tuition, the Pug Gabrel Scholarship Fund will also donate an additional \$500 to Woodward Christian Academy's general fund for every student who receives a scholarship.

Scholarship Benefits:

Any prospective or enrolled student in the 1st through 12th grades may apply for a scholarship for the current academic year valued from \$500 to \$2000. The scholarship will not cover enrollment and curriculum fees or any extracurricular charges. The scholarships awarded will be based on academics, personal conduct and financial need.

Applications will be accepted until Friday, **August 5th**, and may include up to two students per household.

Scholarships will be awarded Wednesday, **August 9th** at 7:00 p.m. at the WCA campus. Recipients must be present or their scholarship may be forfeited.

Qualifications for Applying for the Scholarship:

Academic

All students must have a "B" average in their previous school year's work, and maintain a "B" average in the scholarship year. Students may lose the scholarship if a "B" average is not maintained at semester break in the current year. All ACE students must maintain academic balance by completing at least 3 PACEs in every subject each 9 weeks. All new students must provide the previous year's report cards. Current WCA student grades will be made available from the office.

Personal Conduct

All students receiving a scholarship must meet all behavior standards as required by WCA. They must consistently exhibit the character traits and attitudes that reflect the best of what it means to be a student at Woodward Christian Academy. A student may lose the scholarship for excessive demerits, any major rules violation, repeated disobedience and disrespect, or any behavior deemed inappropriate by the WCA administration.

Financial

Each family applying for a scholarship should have an appropriate financial need.
